

# ITINERARY FOR 8D 7N REFRESHING OKINAWA + TAIWAN

DAY 01 SINGAPORE / TAIPEI / OKINAWA

Welcome to Okinawa - The Eden of Japan!

Upon arrival in Okinawa, you will be met and transferred for your dinner before checking into your hotel for a good night's rest

Overnight: Pacific Okinawa

#### DAY 02 OKINAWA

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Situated on the northwest Okinawa coast, not far from the picturesque beaches of Onna Village, **Manzamo** is a simple, idyllic location with fantastic view and plenty of Okinawan history. You can closely observe the colourful ocean from the **Busena Underwater Observatory**. Going down the spiral staircase, swimming butterfly fish, anemone fish, etc can be seen on the other side of the glass wall. The Underwater Observatory is an all weathered marine resort featuring a panoramic underwater view of 360degrees. A dazzling and refreshing experience awaits you at **Okinawa Churaumi Aquarium**. The aquarium holds 80 species of corals. It is one of the only few aquariums that keeps whale sharks in captivity and is currently trying to breed them. Close to the aquarium there is a **dolphin show** in which you can watch them perform.

### DAY 03 OKINAWA

(Breakfast / Lunch)

To the south lies **Cape Zampa** where you will make a photo stop for the scenic view. Continue to **Mihama American Village**, large entertainment complex. An American military base is located in the area and the entertainment complex of Americana provides a nostalgic pleasure for residents of the bases as well as an interesting diversion for the locals. View the **Kadena Air Base**. This is a United States Air Force installation on the Japanese island of Okinawa, often referred to as the "Keystone of the Pacific". At present, it is the largest United States Air Force base in the Pacific region. Kadena Air Base is home to the Air Force's largest combat air wing, the 18th Wing. Continue to **Shuri Castle**, believed to have been built in the 14th century. Architectural characteristics of Japan, China and Ryukyu are presented in the building. The site was burnt down in the battle of Okinawa, but part of it was restored and rebuilt. In December 2000, it became a part of the World Cultural Heritage. It's more shopping at the famous **Kokusai Street**, a lively 1.6km street lined with souvenir shops, pubs, hotels and shopping mall.

Overnight: Rizzan Sea Park Hotel

## DAY 04 OKINAWA

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Rise early as you set off for the local **Itoman Market.** Move on to the **Okinawa World** - a theme park about Okinawan culture. The park's main attractions are a massive natural cave, a craft village and a snake museum. With a total length of 5km, **Gyokusendo Cave** is the longest of the many caves in the south of Okinawa Island and the second longest cave in the entire country. 850m of the cave is open to the public and feature spectacular stalactites and stalagmites. The inside of the cave is well maintained and the walk paths are comfortable and well lit. It's shopping time at **Ashibina Outlet Mall**. The Mall is Okinawa's first ever outlet mall, with 70 world brands gathered in one location.

## DAY 06 TAIPEI / YILAN

(Breakfast / Lunch)

This morning, transfer to Yilan and start your day on a fun-filled note at a **local farm** in **Sanxing** and learn the ropes of farming with a **spring onion farming experience**. You will also enjoy a **DIY spring onions pancake** session in the town regarded as one of the prime producers of vegetables in Taiwan. Next, head to **Nangfang'ao**, a fishing port in Yilan and enjoy panoramic view of this city at **observation deck**. This evening, head to **LuoDong Night Market**, some of the local specialities include oyster omelette, fried pork and spring onion pancakes. Tonight, check into a **hot spring hotel** where you can enjoy a rejuvenating hotspring bath.

Overnight: Just Sleep Jiao Xi (onsen) Hotel or similar

## DAY 07 YILAN / TAIPEI

(Breakfast / Lunch)

Today, head to **Memorial Hall Founding of Yilan**, these houses were first build in 1900 where you can see traditional Japanese wooden house pattern with western classic building style. Next, visit the most iconic building of Yilan, **Lanyang Musuem** (admission included) where you can learn about the history, culture, landscape of Yilan. Enroute to Taipei and visit **Shenkeng Old Street**. In Taiwan, the best to have stinky tofu was said to be this rural town; the town is also known as "tofu capital"! Stroll along the rural old town and drive to **Addiction Aquatic Developments** where you can find fresh seafood with many themed restaurants. Enjoy dinner at your own expenses.
